Board of Management:14th June, 2021

Enrolments: there will be 1 Junior Infant class for 2021 – 22. The children will meet their teacher on 17th and 18th June.

I.T. Purchases:

2 ActivPanels have been bought for rooms 11 and 12 at a cost of €6000

6 iPads have been purchased for SET rooms at a cost of €2558

Curriculum
